## PADD Program

The Nevada Disability Advocacy & Law Center (NDALC) is a private, nonprofit organization that serves as Nevada's federally-mandated, governor-designated protection and advocacy system for the human, legal, and service rights of Nevadans with disabilities.

NDALC provides services for adults and children with developmental disabilities under the Protection & Advocacy for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities (PADD) program.

### PADD SERVICE PRIORITIES:

- Early Intervention Services. NDALC will advocate for infants and toddlers with developmental disabilities to obtain appropriate and timely early intervention services and transition services.
- Special Education Services. NDALC will advocate for students with developmental disabilities who are being denied educational opportunities in the least restrictive environment with the appropriate supports and related services.
- Abuse & Neglect. NDALC will investigate serious incidents involving serious injury or death in facilities and other supervised living arrangements to ensure healthy and safe living environments.
- Rights in Facilities. NDALC will advocate for the personal rights mandated by federal and state law for individuals in institutional settings.
- Community Integration. NDALC will advocate for the most integrated setting appropriate for individuals with developmental disabilities and will ensure that appropriate support services are provided.

## HOW TO CONTACT NDALC

NDALC's services are available statewide. All requests for services are assessed on a case-by-case basis and will be evaluated based upon NDALC's current service priorities.
