The Nevada Disability Advocacy & Law Center (NDALC) is a private, nonprofit organization that serves as Nevada's federally-mandated, governor-designated protection and advocacy system for the human, legal, and service rights of Nevadans with disabilities.

NDALC is committed to advocating for the prevention, public awareness, and education for people living with traumatic brain injuries (TBI) and their families under the Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Tramatic Brain Injury (PATBI).

PATBI SERVICE PRIORITIES:

NDALC provides services to individuals with TBI pursuant to funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services - Health Resources and Services Administration, Maternal and Child Health Bureau. NDALC's PATBI program will provide:

- Direct representation in certain cases
- Information and referral
- Specific assistance in self-advocacy
- Collaboration with other agencies to support individuals with TBI.

If you currently reside in Nevada and have a traumatic brain injury, you may be eligible to receive NDALC's assistance.

(Note: NDALC is not able or authorized to assist everyone. All requests for services will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and will be evaluated based upon NDALC's current priorities.)

NDALC's services are available statewide. All requests for services are assessed on a case-by-case basis and will be evaluated based upon NDALC's current service priorities and available resources.
