

Nevada Disability Advocacy & Law Center PAVA Program

The Nevada Disability Advocacy & Law Center (NDALC) is a private, nonprofit organization that serves as Nevada's federally-mandated, governor-designated protection and advocacy system for the human, legal, and service rights of Nevadans with disabilities.

NDALC provides education and advocacy to ensure full participation in the electoral process for individuals with disabilities under the Help America Vote Act funds for Protection and Advocacy for Voter Access (PAVA).

PAVA SERVICE PRIORITIES:

- Voter Registration. NDALC provides voter registration assistance and education to individuals with disabilities by distributing Voter Registration Applications at outreach meetings and making them available at its offices or through the mail. NDALC encourages other agencies who provide services to individuals with disabilities to make Voter Registration Applications available.
- Access to Polling Places. NDALC advocates that both State and County Election Officials in Nevada assure that all polling places are accessible. NDALC further advocates that the State and County Election Officials purchase and make available at least one accessible voting machine at each polling place in Nevada.

NDALC assists individuals with disabilities in filing complaints regarding access issues (and other voting issues) under the State of Nevada based grievance procedure.

- Develop and Disseminate Information. NDALC publishes and disseminates information to provide individuals with disabilities the opportunity to register to vote, know their legal voting rights, and access polling places.

HOW TO CONTACT NDALC

NDALC's services are available statewide. All requests for services are assessed on a case-by-case basis and will be evaluated based upon NDALC's current service priorities and available resources.
